

Rules for Users of the LSJ Private Nature Reserve

Exclusive access to the Lac Sir-John Private Nature Reserve has been granted to all members in good standing of the Association Lac Sir-John and their personal guests.

Our role is to act as good stewards of this natural forest reserve; therefore, when visiting the nature reserve, please be aware that following activities are prohibited:

- Always remove any trash, leaving no trace of your presence in the private nature reserve.
- Make no fires; do nothing that could create a fire.
- No use of motorized vehicles (motorcycles, skidoos, ATMs, etc.) except for emergencies, and authorized maintenance, research, or conservation.
- No smoking or vaping of any substance in the private nature reserve.
- No picking and/or removing or disturbing of any vegetation, animals, rocks, or soil.
- No cutting trees, bushes, wildflowers, unless specifically authorized.
- No hunting, trapping, or operation of weapons.
- No deliberate disturbing or frightening of wildlife.
- No camping; except for pre-approved, organized and supervised, wilderness camping experiences for our Association members.
