


LSJ protect the 'SUMMIT'

View of the 'SUMMIT' from Lake Sir John

Development by GSLL halted!



To protect 'SUMMIT' (48 acres) in perpetuity we must fundraise.



- 16 new lots, 6-7 with a view on LSJ
- New wide road built to municipal standards, 500 m long by 20 m
- Trees cut for the road, construction of houses and better view of LSJ
 - Increased water runoff
 - Erosion
 - More trees lost to wind storms
- Stream to Lake Sir John at risk




View of LSJ from the 'SUMMIT'.

LSJ not visible with foliage so more trees will be removed for the view.






Similar elevation to Upper Lookout.

CONSERVATION EFFORTS

PHASE 1 (December 2022)

- Old Forest (63 ha = 156 acres)
- Wetlands (54 ha = 133 acres)

PHASE 2 (December 2023)

Heart of the Domain (35 ha = 86 acres)

TOTAL PRESERVED= 152 ha (375 acres) 55-60 lots avoided

NOW Phase 3 (2024-2025)

- The SUMMIT
- 19,4 ha = 48 acres
- 16 lots were planned





Conservation Lakefield has already raised over \$700K in donations in Phase 1 and 2 and arranged over \$1.0M in Federal and Provincial grants etc. They need to raise \$640K for Phase 3.
